At Pariah, bowling in the same league, also wasn't affected by the weather. He accounted for the top game of the weekend, a strong 236, which helped him compile a 622 series.

Karl Marx followed closely behind. At far second honors with an equally good 233 game in the S.I. Mixed Major League at the Coleman Lanes.

Second honors for series went to Bob Madonewski, who turned in a 632 set, which included two of the weekend's better games.

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Peggy Wins 2nd Pro Tourney

LODI, N.J.—Staten Island's Peggy Maguire, staggered by several lost matches in the semifinals and finals, staged a last-game only which vaulted her from fourth to first place to win the Mid-Atlantic Women's Professional bowling tournament here at Lodi Lanes yesterday.

Peggy was holed in fourth place entering the last game—the 29th of the tourney, trailing the leader, Donna Phillips of Lowell, Mass., by what appeared to be an insurmountable 21 pins.

Peggy, however, bounced back to make up the 21 pin deficit and add a 15 pin lead besides, as she blasted her opponent in the position match with a torrid 227 game. Meanwhile, Donna was her match with a 191 game, but came up 15 pins short of Peggy's winning total.

Peggy jumped off to an excellent start in the qualifying round. She shot 208 for the 10 games (a 208 per game average).

Peggy's average was 208 per game. She was in third place as the fourth was trimmed to 16 women for the semifinals.

A BONUS system of scoring was installed for the semifinals and finals with bowlers receiving 10 bonus pins for every match won. Peggy remained in contention for the lead with a four-game series of 806. She won three matches and advanced to the final in third place.

She struggled through the first two games of the finals, losing both, but rebounded to win the next two. She lost the fifth game and slipped to fourth place entering the last match. Fortunately, her big 227 game and the 10 bonus pins were enough to overtake the leader.

Peggy has dominated the five Mid-Atlantic women's tourneys so far, winning two and finishing second and third in the others. Her victory yesterday earned her \$100.

Her 29 game total, without the bonus pins, was 672—a 207 average per game. She lost the tourney. What happened was the fact that she experienced difficulty in winning matches through the semifinals and finals.

Donna Phillips finished second with 680. Bobby Weiner of Queens finished third.

It was the 11th time in 14 All-Star appearances that Weber picked up a paycheck. He total All-Star title and his winnings easily top the money list. Don Carter, also of St. Louis, is second with \$7,000 in previous All-Star tourneys.

Weber tripped fellow townsman Nelson Burton Jr., in the three-game championship roll-off, 684-681. The three-pin difference was the closest margin lead in the first game, 225-178, in the five years that a three Weber's advantage was used to settle the championship.

Weber started out as if he were going to make it a race way, but ultimately needed a flying start in the third game to hold off Burton.
