# Get ready for a wheel-y big show

More than 30,000 cyclists will end Five Boro Bike Tour at Fort Wadsworth

Cyclists from all over will convene on May 1 at the Gateway National Recreation Area in Fort Wadsworth to relax and celebrate after cycling for 42 miles through all five boroughs of New York while participating in the 28th annual Five Boro Bike Tour.

The event is sponsored by Edn Edition in association with the City of New York and the New York City Department of Transportation. Cyclists from all over will convene on May 1 at the Gateway National Recreation Area in Fort Wadsworth to relax and celebrate after cycling for 42 miles through all five boroughs of New York while participating in the 28th annual Five Boro Bike Tour.

The race, which began 28 years ago with just 20 racers, is the largest recreational cycling event in the United States. It will kick off in Manhattan on Church Street and will go through Central Park and Harlem on its way toward the Bronx.

Racers will then re-enter Manhattan, travel down the FDR Drive and over the 59th Street Bridge into Queens. After a neighborhood tour of Queens, riders will take the Pulaski Bridge into Brooklyn and then head across the Verrazano to Fort Wadsworth.

There are four rest areas before racers reach the festival at Fort Wadsworth, where cyclists can eat and get massages and listen to live music.

**Janelle Vantrease**, who works for Sustainable Consultants, which represents the Five Boro Bike Tour said that

at the close of business on Monday (April 18) there were 2,400 registrants for the race and roughly 450 of those were cyclists from Staten Island.

At this point last year, there were about 10,000 registered cyclists.

"It looks like we are well on our way to 20,000 or more (cyclists) this year," Vantrease said.

Even though the date to register has passed, interested parties can still register in one of two ways. The first is to do so at the Youth Hostel building at 801 Amsterdam Avenue on the Upper West Side on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m.

and on Tuesday and Thursday nights until 7 p.m. The office will also be open for registration Saturday and April 30 from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Bikers can also register the day of the race in Battery Park from 6:30 to 7:45 a.m. at a cost of \$55 for adults and \$30 for youth riders.

**ISLANDERS HELP FDN TO HOCKEY WIN**

In fact, six Islanders had a hand in the victory, which saw the FDNY explode for four third-period goals after trailing 3-1 entering the final 20 minutes.

Among the island players were goaltender **Kevin Ryan**, defenseman **Rob Petracca** and forwards **Rich Baratta**, **Rob Serra**, **Anthony Antemucci** and **Tom Reno**. Another Islander, forward **Vin Capizzi**, is on the team, but didn't play because of an injury.

"The Staten Island guys are the heart and soul of our team," said FDNY general manager **Bill Kammerer**.

"Most of them are the young guys on our team, only in their second or third year, and they always give us a spark."

According to Kammerer, Ryan was particularly impressive against the NYPD. The netminder made several stops off breakaways.

"He was excellent," Kammerer added. "Some of those guys came in in the third period with the game on the line."

Trailing 3-1 entering the third, the FDNY's **Rob Brown**, a Long Island resident, solidified MVP honors after scoring the tying and winning goals.

With the victory, the FDNY owns the all-time series edge with a 17-13-2 record.
