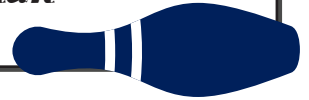

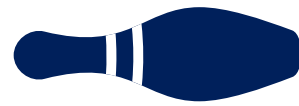

She returned to the sport in her twenties and has been an integral part of the Staten Island bowling community ever since. Joanne has served as the secretary of the Friday Night Mixed Quartets league at Rab's Country Lanes for over 22 years.

She first held the role of Staten Island USBC Association Manager from 2007 to 2015 and returned to the position in 2022, continuing her dedicated service to the bowlers of Staten Island. Joanne has also served on the Board of Directors, Hall of Fame Committee, Tournament Committee, and Lane Inspection Committee, and recently represented SIUSBC as a delegate at the USBC National Convention.

Her commitment to ensuring all local accomplishments are recognized is a testament to her passion and service to the sport.

Superior Performance

Anne Marie Rubilotta's passion for bowling began as a child, inspired by watching her mother compete in morning leagues at Sunset Lanes. That spark turned into a lifelong love for the sport, which she has now enjoyed for more than three decades.

A fierce competitor and consistent performer, Ann Marie made history as the first woman to roll a perfect 300 game in the 63-year history of the Staten Island USBC Women's Championship Tournament. She has recorded four sanctioned 300 games, multiple 700 series with a high of 798, and two 299 games. In 2017, she held the association's highest women's average at 217, and she has maintained a 200+ average for over 20 years.

Ann Marie is a past SIUSBC board member and a proud recipient of numerous honors, including League Triple Crown titles and Women's Championships titles. Through it all, she values the friendships, joy, and personal growth the sport continues to bring.
